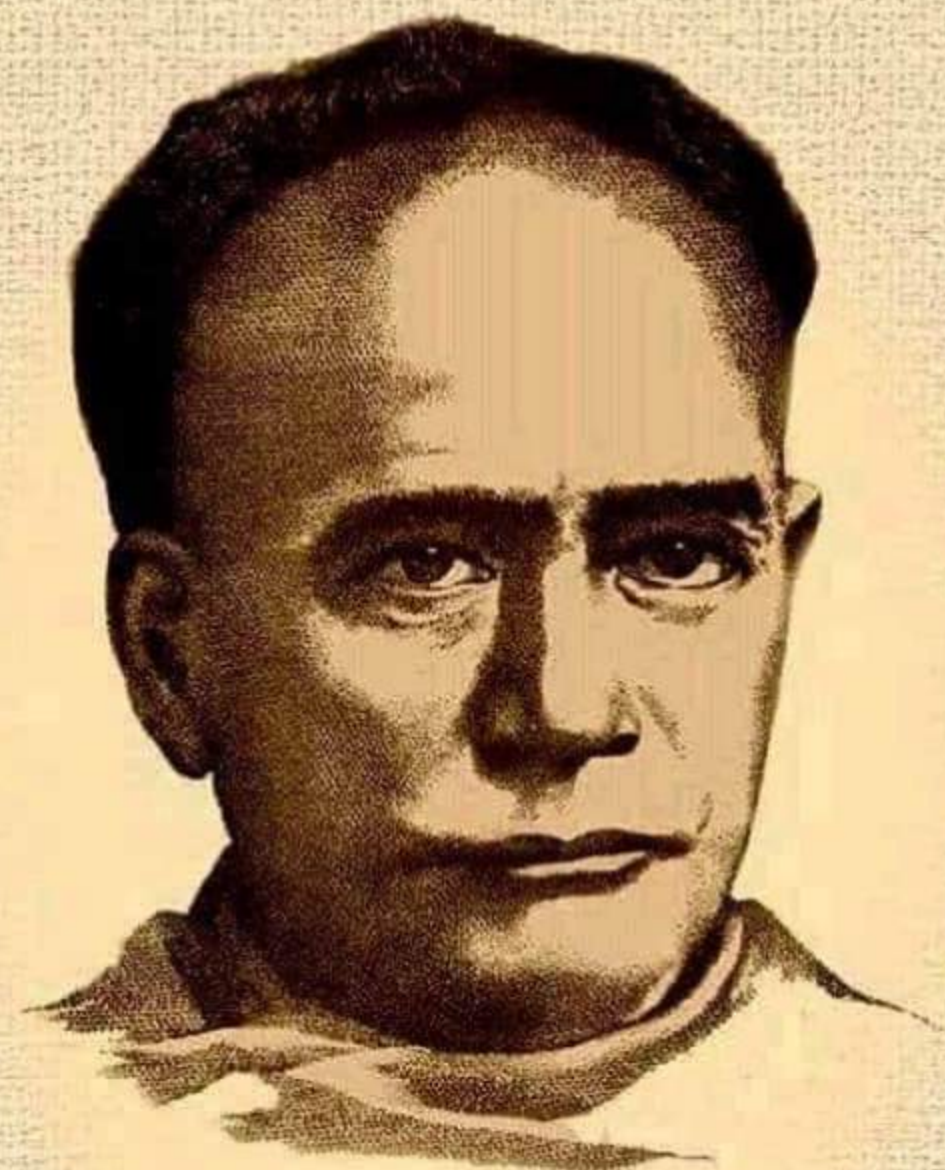

The B.Ed. curriculum has an entire paper devoted to Inclusive education (1.4.10) under which trainees visited to Moyna Ramkrishnan Association (school for blind) on 14.07.2023 at 11AM to 2PM. The trainees were accompanied by Dr. Biswajit Sen, Dr. Kishwar Badakhshan, Dr. Ranita Banerjee and Ratna Biswas of this institution. These teacher educators supervised the tour and guided students through the nuances of the visit. The trainees visited the inclusive classrooms and observed how the teachers were teaching them. Trainees also visited the Resource Room which hoarded tons of teaching equipments. The teachers of inclusive school showed the trainees how each of the equipment worked and explained how learners are benefitted from it. Trainees also visited the library which contained useful books for children. The trainees were given a campus tour to become acquainted with the infrastructure of Inclusive schools.



Visit to Shree Narayan Vidyabhaban Boys' School for Practicum on Curriculum and Practicum on Guidance and Counselling (18.07.2023)

Guidance and counselling is the process of helping individuals discover and develop their educational, vocational, and psychological strengths and lead to a path of personal happiness and social usefulness. The B.Ed. curriculum has an optional paper devoted to Guidance and Counselling for 4th sem under which trainees visited to Colonelgola Sri Narayan Vidyabhaban Boys High School Midnapore, West Bengal on 18.07.2023 at 11AM to 2PM. 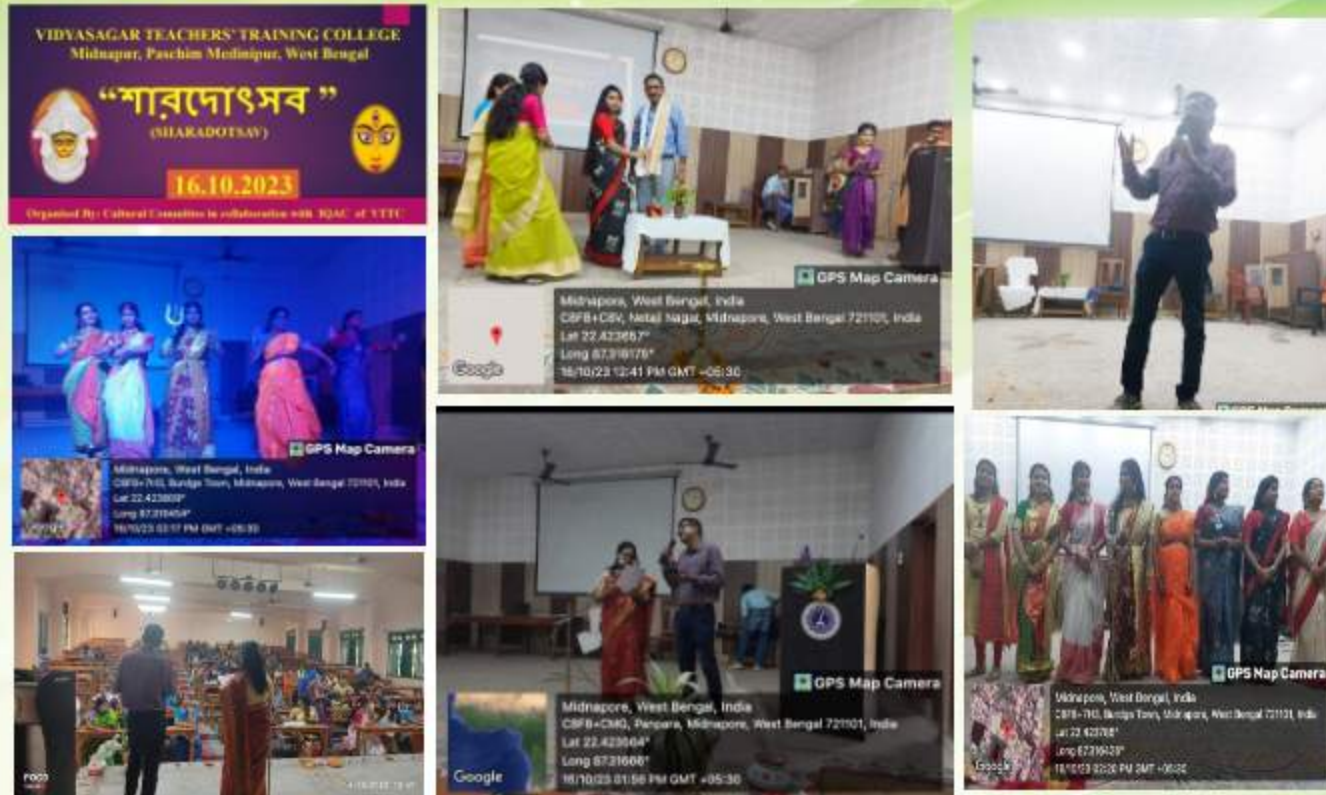

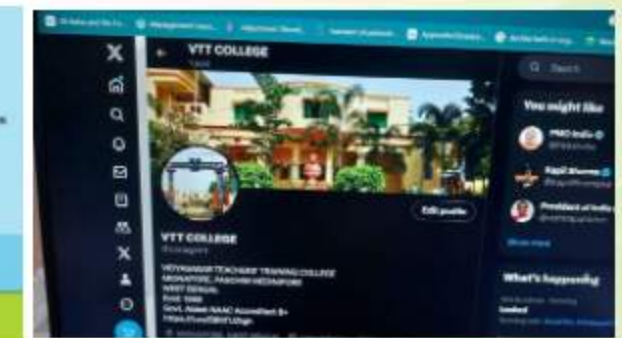
